Mexico has a long tradition of asylum and refuge as it works toward the global compact for orderly, safe and regular migration for refugees with a focus on social inclusion which eradicates intolerance, prejudice and racism.

And let us not forget the flowers. Mexico is one of 17 countries in the world that are mega diverse when it comes to flora and fauna being home to 26,000 species of flora. It stands 2nd to world ecosystems with 34 unaltered ecosystems, 17 sanctuaries and protected areas for flora and fauna. We celebrate the bio-richness of this country. We commend Mexico's commitment to the preservation & conservation of its coastal ecosystems including the preservation of its seven species of sea turtles laying their eggs on Mexican shores. Mexico is a place of endless fascination. It's a place of culture, history and great historic achievements.

Since 1990, beginning with Canada, our peace gardens span five continents.
